Miss Teen, Miss, Mrs., and Prestige title holders may not compete in another pageant while holding the title. However, Teen State and Regional Titles may compete in their High School Pageants.
- 5. Entrant must provide all documents, completed paperwork and photographs and entry fee balance as outlined in the General Information by the deadline.
- 6. Entrants must submit the completed application and non-refundable \$150.00 deposit to begin the application acceptance process.
- 7. The State winner/queen will represent her state and attend National Pageant.
- 8. Entrants must be, and continue to be of good moral character, has not committed crimes resulting in imprisonment, and has not appeared nude or provocative in photographs, films or publications.
- 9. Judges can/will look at social media post. We want you to promote your community service, your title and the system.
- 10. Entrants should be on time. If you are tardy, points can/will be deducted unless prior approval is given.
- 11. The State contestants will be bound to the rules and regulations stated or implied as outlined by the Contestant Agreement as provided by The All-Star United States, LLC.
- 12. Entrants will conduct themselves in a manner that reflects professionalism towards themselves, the State and National Pageant, State Pageant Director, other entrants, and the State prior to, during and throughout her reign as a Local Delegate or State delegate.
- 13. The All-Star United States, LLC reserves the right to disqualify applicants, prior to the Pageant without reimbursement of fees paid.
- 14. All deposits, fees or advertisement sales are non-refundable for any reason.
- 15. Entrants failing to comply with the implied, mentioned and /or understood Rules and Regulations will result in disqualification.
